Official historiography has described this violent incident as the apex of ingratitude, completely misreading this salient example of the potential of awareness. The plantation owner had made the terrible mistake of destroying the justificatory discourse of white supremacy among perplexed slaves. The master accomplished in minutes what centuries of hereditary slavery had failed to do and perhaps another century might not achieve. In the fear of his own God, he had admitted to the enslaved with sacramental humility that they were his equals, which instantly freed them from mental slavery. They now knew that the

slave owner was not a superior, civilized being, but a shameless tyrant, who knowingly abused them to shackle their freedom and steal their labor. The slave 'mentality' – whatever that means - evaporated on the spot, giving way to awareness. This brings us to a simple working definition of awareness for transformative action. Awareness is seeing an escape route from a dire situation.

There is no compelling reason why obesity should go hand in hand with starvation. Happiness is possible without misery for all. The poor do not sleep because they are hungry and the rich do not sleep because they fear the hungry poor. One would think that 75 years after Josué de Castro wrote this in Geography of Hunger (1946), humankind would have invented a more pleasant reason to stay awake.

In nature, the first act of survival is food sovereignty, the ability to feed oneself, rather than mortgaging one's life chances to the mega-corporations that monopolize the food chain. A species that cannot feed its members has no right to exist in the universe. When food and medicine become commodities, hunger and life become commodities. This explains why the misfortune of billions of people goes hand in hand with the trillions of profits made by the food and medicine industries. While local food is the norm in evolution, the 15 largest fast-food chains, all based in the United States, have more than 250,000 locations worldwide.

How outrageous can this get? In countries in the Amazon rainforest, you can buy imported bottled water, while the Amazon River pours 209,000 cubic meters (55 million gallons) of fresh water, produced by tropical rains, into the Atlantic Ocean every second. Meanwhile, the streams and rivers of the Guianas, which means Land of Water in the indigenous language, deliver huge quantities of discarded plastic water containers to the sea.

Food dependency has turned self-sufficient communities into a zoo, fed from the outside by those who dominate the food chain, targeting everything from local organic crops to traditional eating habits to

breastfeeding. Refusing to play by the rules of the game or be held hostage to the international free food market comes at a price. Today, opting for autonomy and survival in a self-driven development strategy that mobilizes one's own food potential is grounds for international boycott. But a single hungry person in the world begging for food makes every billionaire guilty. Animals teach us every day to share food for the group to survive. Can we not learn from their instinct? When will humanity start eating together? The day when food once again arrives in baskets and not in container ships that pollute our oceans. But that may require another version of humanity that is no longer the most harmful species on Earth.

The term was taken without proper reference from the 1980 UN Report "World Conservation Strategy: Living Resources for Sustainable Development" while stripping it of the conservation ethic, "to come to terms with the reality of resource limitation and the carrying capacity of ecosystems."

What we need is not 'clean energy for a dirty system' or painting our cabin in pretty colors, while the ship sinks, but a sustainable humanity in harmony with nature. Our greatest sin has been "anthropocentrism," which

means that man is at the center of the universe, because we like to imagine that man is nature's goal. It has gotten us into deep trouble, because there is no technological solution to anthropocentrism!

this madness of using harmful disposable plastic immediately with a worldwide ban. Countries that fail to do so should be rated negatively.

Replacing plastic with paper from the trees of the Amazon rainforest - the beautiful greenhouse where I was born - is not a solution. A polemic about the "best" waste, as long as waste remains the main product of humanity, is useless! We are stepping on our previous footprints before nature has had time to erase them! We need to reset an economic system focused on profit maximization, incompatible with the satisfaction of needs, which always culminates in a saturation point. In nature, one grows to maturity and then stops growing to enjoy the fruits of growth. Transforming nature into bank accounts and overproducing for eternal growth by artificially reducing the lifespan of products is a recipe for collapse. An environmentally friendly version of grandpa's car that served him for 30 years, and so on, reduces current production volume, energy abuse and waste by 75%. Scientific claims are not

always our best advisors. Modern economics, based on the axiom of perpetual growth, is not a scientific discipline, but the doctrine of a market economy and an ideological instrument for the maintenance of the system. Let us be modest, listen to each other and respectfully unite our talents to rescue our future.

Their common root is Hegel's Eurocentric fable that history has traveled from East to West. Europe is the future face of all with its mantra "What was good for the West is best for the rest."

The failed narratives of modern civilization have put us on a collision course with nature. The largest existing communist country features state capitalism as part of its strategy for global hegemony and the most powerful capitalist country champions anti-capitalism rejecting free competition, free markets and free trade, in order to become great again in defiance of its own economic laws. Hegemonic struggles, no longer with coal but with the threat of nuclear power, have made the possibility of a Third World War a breakfast conversation.

Humanity can no longer wait for a reset, because 'the time that will tell' has already told! We must refuse to be part of a powerless crowd passively waiting for the golden wand of the predatory, warmongering system of superpowers, corporate tycoons, warlords and the dwindling one percent. Those who threaten peace, life, love and our stay on Earth have no moral authority to speak. If we believe their tales, we are sleepwalking into extinction. Rather than hope for salvation through another system maintenance theory, we must reclaim the narrative.

AN EMPIRE IN DANGER IS A DANGEROUS EMPIRE

The second cold war pits U.S. anti-capitalism against Russian/Chinese capitalism. Free market and free competition? This is what communism longs for today to conquer the world economy, while to become great again the champion of capitalism rejects these pillars of capitalism. The fall of the Berlin Wall showed that the prison was on both sides. Let us wait for the demise of capitalism before celebrating the death of communism. In the meantime, let us begin to build on the ruins of capitalism and communism a just and eco-friendly world where life seeks more life and no one decides for others how to die.

REFORESTATION DOES NOT RESULT IN A FOREST: IT RESULTS IN **A PLANTATION**

Destroying forests is like a parasite that kills its host. Since every tree we plant is a blessing, reforestation is a virtue, but first we must keep our forests intact.

When we returned from one of our twelve four-day mountaintop annual retreats (https://crscenter.com/amazon.pdf) in the Amazon rainforest that helped shape *Quest to* Rescue Our Future, where two Franco/Chilean artists had just presented their beautiful https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8yyuS 20x52c&t=88s, Praise of the Tree, we saw a 500-year-old felled tree on a loader truck and said to each other that restoring the forest and the ecosystem to its original state would take 500 years. Reforestation is all very well,

but it does not result in a forest; it produces a plantation. The great battle for survival (one of the battles) is to put eco into command. Eco means home and is the common root of economy and ecology. Let us live from what nature generously offers us while keeping our home intact, intensifying the struggle to maintain the purpose with which evolution has endowed the forest.

INDIGENOUS RIGHTS TO ANCESTRALLANDS NEVER EXPIRE

Indigenous people know how to survive and thrive by keeping the forest intact, because they know that ecology and economy should be in balance, given their common root 'eco', which means home. Indigenous rights to ancestral lands never expire because they were appropriated by an intruder on the day a guest declared himself the host. In the words of the Mayan prophet Chilam Balam: "The colonizers came to wither the flowers. To nourish their own flower, they harmed and sucked the flower of others." (The Books of Chilam Balam, early 16th century). Thousand flowers will bloom again!

MODERN CIVILIZATION HAS FAILED AS A PROJECT FOR HU-MANITY AND CAN OFFER NO OP-TION FOR SURVIVAL

Humanity has become the Frankenstein of evolution. Some of the monsters: war is the guardian angel of peace, nuclear weapons for 'deterrence', predatory economy, environmental collapse, the cult of billionaires, authoritarian rule, the caricature of democracy, surveillance, artificial intelligence overtaking us, religious fundamentalism, selfishness as the supreme virtue, globalizing the majority into extinction, the moral quagmire

Step out of your comfort zone or your activism for a minute and share your thoughts about an extrasystemic solution! Rather than adding to the list of troubles, contribute to the solution that 95% of our species and 99.9% of our youth are waiting for.

Rehumanization of a dehumanized humanity is the imperative recipe for survival. Let us open the window of opportunity in the hands of humanity's moral reserves, still in the majority.

WAR IS THE GUARDIAN ANGEL OF PEACE

The goal of all war is peace! Since all contending parties share this as a sacred ambition, the best definition of war is the struggle between peace and peace. War, as the first beneficiary of human intellect and creativity, has trespassed the survival heaven with nuclear, chemical, biological, cyber and AI-enabled capabilities. Superpowers seeking hegemony are turning nations into innocent victims (Vietnam, Middle East, Ukraine) and generals fighting for monopoly of power are decimating their own people (Sudan). When will we put an end to this madness of making economy (needs), religion (ethics)

and tribe (community) the primary drivers of war?

This is the desperate 1955 manifesto of Einstein and Russell: "Here, then, is the problem which we present to you, stark and dreadful and inescapable: Shall we put an end to the human race; or shall mankind renounce war?" Shall we compose a requiem or a song of joy? The imperative first step is for the moral reserves of humanity to take command of our destiny and rehumanize a dehumanized humanity.

TRANSCENDING DARWIN'S NATURAL SELECTION TO REHUMANIZE A DEHUMANIZED HUMANITY

Rehumanizing humanity is the most important challenge for the survival of our species. People understand the urgency, but still wonder how to do it and whether we have not already gone too far. Rehumanization is not a far-fetched overnight slogan, but the result of decades of reflection and discussion that have shaped the book 'Quest to Rescue Our Future' (https://www.rescueourfuture.org/quest), which chronicles the trajectory of humanity, diagnoses our current misfortunes, identifies dangerous trends, charts desirable and feasible futures, locates transformative social forces, and analyzes strategy and actions that can shape a different version of humanity.

This fascinating story of discovering the driving force of evolution draws on the thinking of several philosophers such as Arthur Schopenhauer (the will to live), Albert Schweitzer (reverence for life), Hans Jonas (responsibility and accountability for future life), and the new understanding of development in Quest to Rescue

Our Future, which identifies "Life seeks more life" as the driving force of evolution.

People are responding to this holistic approach, which analyzes today's fourfold existential challenge from an evolutionary, historical, contemporary and future perspective. Darwin to W. H. Harvey [20-4 September 1860]

"If I had to rewrite my book, I would use "natural preservation" or "naturally preserved". I shd. think you would as soon take an emetic as reread any part of my Book, but if you did & were to erase selection & selected & insert preservation & preserved, possibly the subject would be clearer."

Darwin to Asa Gray 26 September

"If I had to write my book again I would use "Natural Preservation" & drop "Selection", but it is too late now."

HUMANITY ON AUTOPILOT TO **EXTINCTION**

Time for an extrasystemic reset

Humanity has traveled from the gate of the cave to the brink of the grave. Privileging profit over the satisfaction of needs to accumulate wealth by subjecting nature to the whims of man has plunged us into an existential crisis. system to rid itself of an unreliable life companion that has become a liability.



In doing so, we surrendered to system narratives of greening greed, such as 'sustainable development' for system maintenance, clean energy for a dirty system, a circular economy that cannot keep up with spiraling waste, and sunflower horror - aerosols blocking solar energy. These narratives disguised as development went hand in hand with the destruction of the most reliable carbon sequestration machines and the most efficient solar panels: Trees. There is no technological solution to the cosmic solitude of anthropocentrism. With no idea how to escape our precarious situation, the environmental movement is mired in disbelief, defeatism and despair, as humanity dances a dangerous tango

on the fault lines of evolution. Harmony with nature is a prerequisite for life and prosperity. Our survival now boils down to a timely extrasystemic reset that connects with the driving force of evolution, which is 'life seeking more life'.

On the last lap before the exit, this is an SOS call to all transformative movements of humanity to take a deep look in the mirror. To fight for a better world, we must bring together the moral reserves of humanity in a joyous extrasystemic movement to rescue our future, to take back the wheel from the drunk drivers of modernity. Those who think this is a bridge too far are rejecting the last window of opportunity and the only bridge to survival.

The fatalism of pessimists breeds the same apathy as the anesthesia of hope. SLAVE SKIN AS COLONIAL COMMUNICATION INTERFACE



One hundred and sixty years ago, on July 1, 1863, slavery was 'abolished' in the Dutch Caribbean colonies. The horrors of twentyfive generations of hereditary slavery are well documented, but the heavily distorted surviving colonial documents are an obstacle to understanding its true magnitude. Perhaps the less subjective exercise of Quest to Rescue Our Future will help us assess the impact of forced labor in the Americas.

"An estimated four billion cubic meters of slave sweat, in more than a hundred thousand days of Indian and black slavery from Mexico to Patagonia and from São Paulo through the Caribbean up to New York, gives a sense of the value produced by forced labor." (Based on 60% of the maximum amount a person can sweat per day, p. 67.) How about a dollar value per ounce for reparations?

While this large figure reveals much about history, the most telling evidence of inhumanity I encountered in my long travels through literature is a small incident between two colonial plantation owners in 18th century Suriname.

"John Gabriel Stedman (1744–1797), a captain in the colonial army that combatted maroons in the interior of Suriname in the eighteenth century, narrates a minor incident

between two colonial plantation owners that goes to the heart of the deep immorality of slavery. 'At Arentrust, a few plantations lower down, some days before, a poor negro was sent with a letter from his proprietor to the manager there – this last not liking the contents, gave the messenger four hundred lashes, telling the innocent man, at the same time, to carry that for the answer to his master.' The message fused with the messenger as his body carried back the response. Slave skin became the interface for colonial communication." (Quest, p. 68)

A dependent slave became an independent slave and humanity is still waiting to emancipate itself from mental slavery, the first step to rescue our battered future.

SQUARING A VICIOUS CIRCLE,

Fossil fuels will fossilize us all and clean energy for a dirty system is a palliative in the hospice

Humanity has disconnected from the driving force of evolution, which is 'life seeking more life', and is dangerously altering the exceptional condition that made life on Earth possible. The real problem is anthropocentrism, our imagination that man is the purpose of the universe. Modern civilization has failed as a project and can offer no survival option! There is no technological solution to anthropocentrism. We need an extrasystemic reset that rehumanizes a dehumanized humanity, before evolution activates its immune system to rid itself of a Frankensteinian monster that is putting life in mortal danger. The satisfaction of needs could easily settle for a quarter of today's energy abuse for profit maximization. We need an

extrasystemic solution in the hands of humanity's moral reserves to stop our road to suicide or euthanasia. Yes, better a stone age than no age! Our cosmic challenge to rescue our future is too big for a cryptic post. See the full argument of 25 years of reflections in this life's work.

Evolution is so generous to offer the main culprit of distress one last chance before it activates its immune system to get rid of the species that is putting life in mortal danger. We must decide whether we throw in the towel and become the humanosaurus of the future or put on gloves* for an extrasystemic reset. There is a beautiful law in evolution that when faced with the prospect of extinction, all species become creative in finding a survival option. Let us join forces with the other moral reserves of humanity to rescue our future in harmony with nature inspired by the driving force of evolution, which is 'life seeking more life'.

GOLDEN RULE OF CREATIVITY: WRITE BEFORE YOU READ, MAKE CONTEXT THE HOME OF TEXT AND NEVER DEBATE

Three blasphemous rules were the recipe for graduation at well-known universities of many candidates of the PhD School of a small island I coordinated for a decade.

- 1. Debates are not allowed!
- 2. Write first, then read!
- 3. No text without context!

Students would literally take over my next class:

"I can write now. No more writer's block!"

"I've shelved the books for a while!"

"I'm no longer afraid of the blank page!"

"I've become creative overnight!"

"I no longer have to go to the fridge, without the slightest appetite!"

"I am no longer a parrot, but a spider spinning my own web."

"My writing is no longer a collage, but so much fun!"

Some quick impressions of this game-changing story that everyone can benefit from.

Debate

The neurotic effort to prove that one in 'right' and to defend one's 'truth' by overruling 'alternative truths' is an intellectual malpractice. Debates belong in the courtroom and in parliament to free murderers and enforce double agendas. Truth exists in theology, not in science. The goal of science is not to find truth, but to reduce the degree of speculation with the best guess available for the time being. Science is the never-ending search for perishable truths. Given the prominent role that falsification plays in science, scientific certainty is unscientific. This calls for self-criticism, respectful discussion and constructive pluralistic dialogue. In a quest,

no one is 'right', which leaves no room for debates in defense of dogmatic beliefs.

First write, then read

Thinking and writing before you read is the best firewall to avoid selling one's soul to the established wisdom of self-proclaimed centers of excellence. Intellectuals who let others do the thinking become agents of system maintenance under the tyranny of a 'knowledge' oligarchy. With careful observation and critical reflection you write from the heart, while passive reading through the eyes of others produces obese fast-food bookworms, skilled ruminators and sophisticated legal plagiarists. The bookshelf is the testing ground for new insights, not the source of knowledge.

Text without 'con-text' is hallucination

Context-free knowledge reminds us that science divorced from reality is science fiction. In a quest without blueprints, nothing is set in stone except our unwavering commitment to strive for a better version of humanity, even against the tide. The path of discovery is a quest where nothing is set in stone. The secret lies in restoring innate storytelling, not alienating academic writing, a system-imposed cult that values form over content. A fusion of critical thinking and transformative action, untainted by parochial interests, can pave a better path to the future than sophisticated forecasting, because in the quest to rescue our future, action is the best prediction.

EXISTENTIAL CRISIS: SAPIENS WITHOUT ANIMAL WISDOM LOOKING FOR A NEEDLE IN THE WRONG HAYSTACK



During my morning walk, this surprisingly simple manifestation of "life seeking more life", which is the engine of evolution, reminded me of the worldwide frustration of millions of courageous environmental and peace activists. Naively believing that we could reform from within the system that feeds on our misfortunes, we have been looking for a needle in the wrong haystack. You can't transform hell while the devil brings more coal. We've given in to system-maintenance gimmicks like clean energy for a dirty system, recycling the ever-increasing waste of perpetual growth, and war as the guardian angel of peace, and evil has run rampant.

Humanity has gone astray and is now mired in existential problems. Anthropocentrism, the imagination of being the purpose of the universe, has disconnected humanity from the safe haven of evolutionary harmony. The domination of nature quickly extended to the domination of people, culture and mind. All the intellect of instinct-poor sapiens could not guarantee social intelligence and avoid suicidal paths. Animals fly to higher ground, watching people inquisitively approaching the receding waterline before the tsunami hits.

We need a reset. Modern civilization, pinnacle of the cosmic solitude of anthropocentrism, has failed as a project of humanity. Under its watch, we traveled from the gate of the cave to the brink of the grave. Its major institutions have been stripped to become system-maintenance devices, as is the case with the predatory economic system, mainstream science, fundamentalist religions, partisan politics and the media for mass excommunication with peer-reviewed fake news. Nature now urges us with the intonation of a last call to reconnect with the symphony of life before evolution activates its immune system to rid itself of a dangerous anomaly.

Instead of remaining trapped in the shadow of evil, we need an extrasystemic solution for a new version of humanity. The only force left to rehumanize a dehumanized humanity is humanity's moral reserves.

Since in a quest nothing is set in stone, we must avoid debates between rival 'truths'. Instead, in a dialogue between change agents for cross-fertilization there is room to enlighten peers, add your grain of salt, listen and reflect or simply recharge your batteries. The worst remedy for impending disaster is the anesthesia of optimism, but in these testing times, let's leave the superstition of pessimism for better days. Action is the best prediction!

This Zoom meeting was triggered by the LinkedIn post 'Life seeks more life' and the many comments it generated. NO SUSTAINABILITY WITHOUT HARMONY WITH NATURE



Sunday's ride around the island of Aruba captured a simple testimony of living in harmony with nature. 'Eco' (home), the common root of economy and ecology, belies the polarization of modern civilization that leads to unsustainability, discontinuity and existential crises. Survival is impossible without harmony with nature. This is not a scientific discovery, but a law of evolution that predates science and astrology.

Humanity's search for truth has gone through four worldviews. The naturalistic era (animism) succumbed to the mythological era (ancestral spirits), which gave way to the theological era (God) until the advent of the scientific era (Reason is the new God). Today, the transition from the scientific to the ethical era is a prerequisite for the survival of humanity.

From the perspective of Evolution, the most dangerous artificial intelligence is the human intellect. A divergence between science and reality leads to a change of theory. A divergence between ethics and reality leads to a change of reality. Science addresses the academic question of what reality is like, but ethics addresses the existential question of what reality should be like. Humanity's survival can no longer be assured by static knowledge, but needs transformative action, which amounts to a successful transition to the ethical era. The immediate goal is a sustainable humanity with ethics and wisdom at

the wheel and science in an honorable back seat of support (https://crscenter.com/sustain.pdf).

Modern civilization has failed as a project in evolution, alienating us from nature and dragging us into the depths of oblivion. Its most powerful system-maintenance strategy is information obesity, an overload of peer-reviewed fake news to impose the system's narrative and create confusion in a state of mental slavery, conducive to apathy and acceptance of the inevitability of our demise. Call it a reset, overhaul, change of mindset, metamorphosis if you will, but we have no choice but to reconnect with evolution and its driving force 'life seeking more life'. Everything else boils down to writing the refrain of our own requiem.

Fortunately, in the quivering morning breeze, there is the whispering voice of humanity's moral reserves, like a full-grown embryo ticking on the cracking eggshell, giving birth to the Rescue Our Future Movement. There is no need to destroy before building because evolution is the best revolution.

We have been looking for a needle in the wrong haystack, coopted by greed-greening system-maintenance narratives, such as clean energy for a dirty system and a circular growth economy, mathematically impossible, since a circle cannot contain spiraling waste, the main product of a mindless 'civilization'.

The system that feeds on our misfortunes will not solve our existential problems. On autopilot towards extinction, we can either sleepwalk on towards our demise or join the moral reserves of humanity, the only remaining social force capable of rescuing our future. FOOD SHOULD COME IN BASKETS. NOT IN CONTAINER SHIPS

"Food, health and shelter sovereignty" is the title of the section of Quest to Rescue Our Future that deals with article 25 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which states that everyone has the "right to life" and "the right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of himself and of his family, including food, clothing, housing and medical care". This is in harmony with the first lesson in the kindergarten of evolution, according to which survival consists in adapting to nature and integrating into the environment, first of all by finding and creating healthy food sources. All the peoples of the Earth have translated this for millennia into delicious meals with healthy spices. But today food and health have become lucrative businesses that undermine health, culture and wellness. The 20 largest

fast food chains (17 of which are US companies, each with billions in revenue) have more than 350,000 fast food restaurants (both domestic and international) in the world. Why should humanity tolerate the health hazard of fast-food chains that undermine food sovereignty with the imposition of unhealthy eating habits, alien to the local culture, detrimental to traditional and local production and harmful of public health? Food should come in baskets, not in container ships!

ANTHROPOCENTRISM: PARADOX OR THE ROOT OF OUR EXISTEN-TIAL PROBLEM?

"Overcoming Anthropocentrism, the Root of Our Existential Crisis", the second dialogue on rescuing our future on April 13, began with a paradox around anthropocentrism. (Watch

"Something I am struggling with is that, because we are human, we will always have an anthropocentric view. It's hard for me not to have an anthropocentric perspective, but I find the belief that humans are the most important creatures in the universe, and that the universe is there just for humans, problematic."

Is selfish survival at the expense of nature sustainable and can parasitism and harmony go hand in hand? In evolution, the only sustainable option is harmony with nature. If humanity does not stop putting life in mortal danger, nature will activate its immune system to get rid of a dangerous anomaly.

This sparked a fascinating dialogue between participants from all continents, one of whom raised the possibility of a "responsible anthropocentrism". But is this really a paradox or just an unfortunate mix-up of terms?

Of course, a rabbit can only look at nature through the eyes of a rabbit. But does that give it the right to claim to be the rightful owner of the forest? To prevent a particular form of life from arrogating to itself dominion over all life, we need a precise term that distinguishes action from 'form', the Greek word for which is 'morphē', the root of a term like metamorphosis.

A rabbit-morphic perspective, based on the rabbit's natural conditions, potential and limitations, does not justify a rabbit-centric worldview as the ruler of the forest.

If we apply this to the most harmful animal on Earth and separate an

anthropocentric worldview from an anthropomorphic one, the paradox dissolves.

We have the power of our five senses, the size of our brains, the power of our minds, the properties of our language in a specific location in a tiny part of the universe, but the scope and size of these unique conditions also limit us to an anthropomorphic worldview.

As human beings, we are inherently anthropomorphic because we have no choice but to act, think and live from the limits, conditions and possibilities of our human perspective. Just as the rabbit has a rabbit-morphic worldview full of carrots, we have a anthropomorphic (responsible?) worldview. But we must vehemently resist an arrogant anthropocentric attitude, as if we were the rulers of the universe, as modern civilization would have us believe.

Anthropocentrism is an invitation to extinction and the root of our existential crisis. Our only chance of survival is to rehumanize a dehumanized humanity by moving from an anthropocentric to a cosmocentric

worldview. The only social force left to initiate this metamorphosis is the moral reserves of humanity, who are at the heart of our ongoing dialogue to rescue our future!

MODESTY IS A VIRTUE

The greatest stupidity of the intellect is when people think they are so smart that they don't need to use their intelligence before they commit their next stupidity. Modesty makes you listen first, ask questions second and speak, if it is still necessary. Not being a slave to established 'wisdom' and accumulated knowledge is the cradle of wisdom, creativity and innovation is an invitation.

WHEN THE DARKNESS OF THE EN-LIGHTENMENT CAME UPON USIT IMPOSED INDIVIDUALISM, A PRI-MARY CONDITION FOR TOTALI-TARIANISM AND ECOLOGICAL COLLAPSE

Individual freedom of "absolutely atomized elements in a mass society is one of the primary conditions for totalitarianism." This unexpected kinship between freedom and totalitarianism was discovered by renowned political theorist Hannah Arendt.

Totalitarianism relies on free individuals without power because it is difficult and costly to discipline an organic community. Arendt shows how Stalin's atomization of the masses made skillful use of purges. Individuals had to face the state "in complete loneliness without any help whatsoever from the group to which they happened to belong". Since the arrest of contacts could

mean immediate danger, shunning social ties was the safest option. The Nazis succeeded in killing the moral person. They "implicated concentration camp inmates... in their crimes by making them responsible for a large part of the administration, thus confronting them with the hopeless dilemma whether to send their friends to their death, or to help murder other men who happened to be strangers, and forcing them, in any event, to behave like murderers."

For totalitarianism, individualism is a powerful instrument for breaking down the social response capacity, which is the built-in assertive power to respond to life's challenges in unison in the pursuit of survival and success. The insularity of individualism weakens the qualities that hold a group together (solidarity, common goals, mutual benefit) and pulls it apart (selfishness, competition, pursuit of wealth, lust for power). The Enlightenment's 'liberation' of the individual from the protective communal shield of kinship, clan and tribe left her defenseless against domination and abuse.

The narrative of freedom, for which many are willing to kill or die, justified colonial and imperial atrocities. Hailed as a precious gift from the West to the rest, freedom was compatible with three hundred years of hereditary slavery. Was it unforgivable negligence or Eurocentric interests that led the great thinkers and philosophers of modern civilization to overlook such an appalling contradiction?

In existential danger, the solution for humanity is to merge many I's into an invincible We. This is the only road from an anthropocentric individualistic society that harms nature, driven by selfishness, competition and greed, to a cosmocentric community driven by solidarity, cooperation and compassion. We need a radical shift from terrorizing the planet to living in harmony with nature. Fortunately, we do not need to start from scratch. To rehumanize a dehumanized humanity, we can find inspiration in the balanced person-community relation as represented in Ubuntu (I exist through you), Sumak Kawsay (Living well in harmony) and

Gobernar Obedeciendo (governing by obeying). This makes the path to rescue our future a beautiful challenge!

SOLUTION TO OUR ECOLOGICAL PROBLEM: LET'S NOT STEP ON OUR PREVIOUS FOOTPRINTS UNTIL NATURE HAS TIME TO ER ASE THEM

A tall order for a species that has disconnected from 'life seeks more life', the driving force of evolution. Life is creatively self-preserving, but the challenge of rescuing our future is even greater than restoring ecological harmony, as the sound of the current war drums remind us.

The ecological crisis is one of four agonies humanity must overcome.
